WHAT IS A HAIR TRANSPLANT?

A hair transplant is a day surgery that permanently restores hair by moving hair follicles or "grafts" from one position to another. The grafts are taken from the back of head (the "donor" area) which contains dense hair growth, and then is surgically implanted to the thinning or balding areas (the "recipient" area).

WHAT IS FUE?

FUE or Follicular Unit Extraction is the most advanced method to perform a hair transplant. The individual grafts are taken individually, so there is minimal pain, no scarring and no stitches are required.

WHAT IS EYEBROW TRANSPLANTATION

The same cutting-edge techniques used by our surgical team at ICCM/Crown Clinic in hair transplantation surgery are used for eyebrow transplants. A fuller appearance to re-establishing lost, over plucked or non-existent eyebrows is now possible.



WHAT IS THE PROCEDURE?

After application of a local anaesthetic to the donor site, the lifelong hair bearing follicles will be individually removed and prepared for transplantation. Once all of these "grafts" are ready for transplant, anaesthetic will be administered to the recipient site, the area will be prepared and then the grafts will be planted. They are very skilfully transplanted at an angle that mimics the natural, pre-hair-loss hairline. The entire procedure can take anywhere from five to ten hours.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT AFTER THE PROCEDURE?

After undergoing hair transplant surgery, you can expect to remain sensitive for the first two to five days after surgery, with only mild pain relief medication recommended to suppress any pain. You will also normally be able to return to your daily routines and activities between two to five days after surgery. Patients can expect the transplanted hair to fall out over the span of two to three weeks post procedure, before new hair growth commences within a few months. New hair growth typically occurs after 3-4 months post surgery.

ARE THERE RISKS INVOLVED IN THE TREATMENT?

Risks are minimal, FUE hair transplantation is very safe. Precautionary courses of antibiotics and anti-inflammatories are issued to minimize any possible swelling and/or infection.

WHAT IS THE RECOVERY TIME?

FUE hair transplantation is a walk in, walk out procedure. Depending on your profession, we recommend a couple of days' rest, and there will be scabbing which lasts up to 12 days. Most patients are able to return to work immediately.
